Criminal Record Check Services:

- If you do not have a Pennsylvania driver's license, go to https://epatch.state.pa.us/ You will want to follow the links starting with New Record Check (Volunteers only).
 - Read the information carefully, then at the bottom of the page click the box that you understand and want to proceed.
 - This will bring you to a page to fill out.
 - Under the Volunteer Organization Name please type "Office of Clinical Studies"
 - Under Volunteer Organization Telephone Number type "302-831-6778"
 - Fill out the rest of the form with your personal information.
 - This is a free clearance. At the bottom of the page click on "next" and then on the next page, verify the information and then click "Proceed".
- If you have a Pennsylvania driver's license, you will need to be fingerprinted.
 - You will need to schedule an appointment through <u>IdentoGo</u> to get fingerprinted for the state background check. An official photo ID and the confirmation number from when you registered are required at the time of fingerprint processing.
 - When you enroll online, be sure to check that it is for **Department of Education** and not Public Welfare.
 - You must use the Service Code (1KG6RT) to ensure that they are processed for the correct purpose.
